Pine River Ride With Us Bus

The Pine River Ride With Us Bus is Public Transportation serving the City of Pine River and up to 3 miles outside the city limits.

Using the Bus System

We're a Dial-A-Ride system (first come first served.) Fares vary based on location.

For safety, passengers MUST wear seat belts.

Eating, drinking and smoking are prohibited.

Driver will assist only through the first public entry of any building. They are not allowed to enter private residences.

We are handicapped accessible!

In Town	\$1.00 one way
Town Limit-1 mile	\$1.25 one way
1- 2 miles	\$1.50 one way
2-3 miles	\$1.75 one way
Each additional stop	\$0.75

We also have a \$12.00 ride ticket available at a discounted rate of \$11.00!

General Rules

The City of Pine River will not tolerate passengers who use profanity, make racial or other disparaging remarks while riding the bus.

The passenger must be ready & waiting at the doorway of pick-up/drop-off location. If a passenger requires assistance into and out of wheelchair, a family member, friend or aid must be present to assist.

If the person is not capable of maneuvering the wheelchair alone, an aid or companion must be available at both ends of the trip to assist the passenger.

Items NOT allowed on the bus.

Animals that are NOT in carriers. Except for trained service animals.

Gasoline and other flammable liquids.

Firearms & air guns.

Open or exposed knives.

Toxic or illegal materials.

Other bulky materials that cannot safely be carried or transported on the bus.

Shirts and Shoes must be worn.
